On my first walks in the woods this year, all I saw were trees. I didn't know many types of trees. I always stayed on the paths. But on this special day I had time on my hands to discover the forest with all senses and to walk outside the known paths.

I sat down, completely hidden in the green of the vegetation, on a fallen tree trunk. I immediately imagined how old this forest was and what stories it had to tell. Prepare the passe-partout.





Measure, clean and conserve the artwork.

My favorites: White Oak Solid Wood frame and Fog Grey passe-partout.




White Oak Solid Wood Frame




Passe-partout
